



## **Intensive Spanish in Mexico Accommodation Information**

### **Homestay Accommodation**

The accommodation for the La Salle University Intensive Spanish in Mexico program will be in homestay.

For students looking to learn or improve their Spanish this is the best type of accommodation, guaranteed to offer a more in depth cultural and linguistic experience for participants.

With the homestay you will stay with a local Mexican family. Every family is slightly different but there are some common features.

- All accommodation is within easy access to La Salle University, where the courses will take place. This is most often within walking distance or, at most, a short metro or bus ride (transport is extremely cheap in Mexico City).
- Homestay accommodation is twin-share. You can nominate who you would like to stay with if you wish.
- The homestay includes two meals per day (breakfast and dinner).
- Towels and sheets will be changed weekly
- Accommodation for 28 days is included as part of the program.

Homestay is a great experience – you will get to live with locals and it is not uncommon to form long lasting friendships through it. The type of 'Family' can vary too – some 'families' have kids, some are retirees, some are working professionals or young couples. La Salle University has had a long experience in placing students into host families close to the university and has, over time, developed a strong base of excellent host families who look after students very well.

That said, while it is rare, if there were any significant issues with your homestay, it would usually be possible to change.

Many students single out their homestay as one of the highlights of their program. We are pleased to offer this as the accommodation option for students on this program.
