About Brno

The town of Brno, in the east of the Czech Republic, is a stunning little town at the cross-roads of Europe. Vienna, Prague, Bratislava are just a few hours away. Second-largest city in the Czech Republic, this charming friendly city is surrounded by beautiful forests and lends itself to cycling everywhere.

Accommodation

Accommodation is twin-share, in students' dormitory, in basic but clean rooms, within easy transport access of the university.

Transport

Getting there:

- To Brno Airport. RyanAir is operating direct and cheap flights between Brno and London (Stansted Airport).
- To Vienna Airport, Austria. You can then reach Brno by bus or train. Vienna is about 2.5h by bus from Brno and the trip costs about 5 to 10 euros (more info at www.studentagency.cz). Or you can take the S-Bahn from the airport to Vienna central station where you can hop on a train to Brno.
- To Prague Airport. You can then reach Brno by bus. The trip takes about 3.5h and costs around 6 euros (more info at www.studentagency.cz).
- To Bratislava Airport – a smaller airport, but some low-cost airlines use it. From there you can take a bus to Brno, the trip will take around 2h and costs about 6 euros.
- By train from most European capitals – see www.cd rail.cz

Getting around:
